Our parent body "Maharshi Karve Stree Shikshan Samstha's has century long history of dedicate work towards making a women educated and self reliant.

In 1896, Maharshi Karve started an ashram at Hingne, near Pune for widows and other helpless women. Despite opposition and with very meager resources, he started a simple programme of schooling for the ashram inmates because he firmly believed that was only through education that they could be made self reliant and free.

About Our University



In December 1915 Karve in his presidential address to the National Social reform Congress at Bombay announced his decision to shape his dream into reality and in 1916 the first college started with the enrollment of five students which gradually took shape as women's university.

The vision of Maharshi Karve and the foresight of Sir Vithaldas Thackersey led to the establishment of the first

Women's University in India. Recognizing the pioneering work of Dr. Karve, Sir Vithaldas Thackersey made a generous contribution of Rs. 15 lacs to commemorate the memory of his mother, Nathibai. In 1920, after the great benefactor's mother Nathibai, the University was named as Shreemati Nathibai Damodar Thackersey Women's University.

Today, SNDT has become a symbol of excellence in higher educational opportunities for women. The journey has been a long one since 1916. There are three university campuses two at Mumbai-Churchgate and Juhu and one at Karve Road, Pune and one at Gujrat, Ahmadabad.

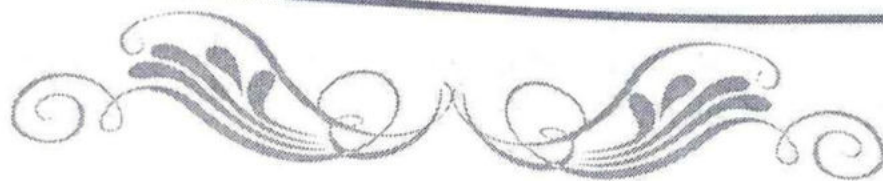

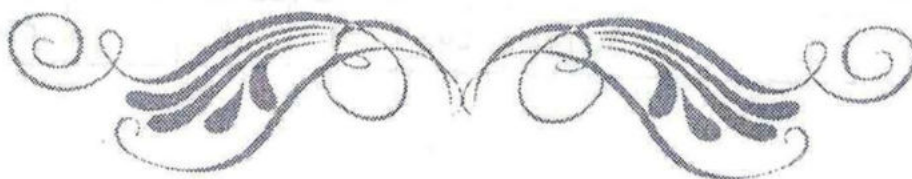
Scope of Bachelor of Arts

Note : Changes in Course Structure for B.Com

1. With effect from academic year 2009-2010 the credit based semester pattern will be introduced at B.Com level. Each Semester will carry 24 credits. Each Credit is equivalent to 15 teaching hours.
2. Commerce I & II will be a compulsory paper (Including Computer Application Students) with effect from 2009-2010.
3. Environmental Studies will be a compulsory paper at semester II for all students. With effect from 2009-2010.
4. Business Law papers I & II will be taught in semesters III & IV instead of specialization paper (at B.Com II - w.e.f. 2010-11)
5. All the specialization papers will be taught in semesters V & VI (at B.Com III w.e.f. 2011-12)
6. Entrepreneurship Development in semester VI will be a common paper of 100 marks for all students offering vocational subjects.

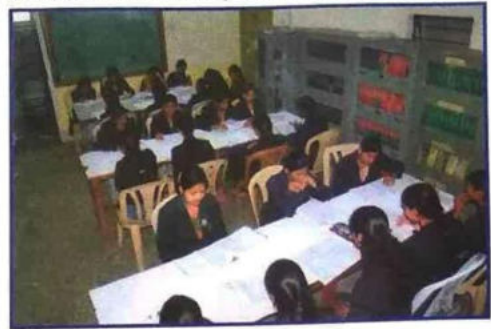
COLLEGE INFRASTRUCTURE

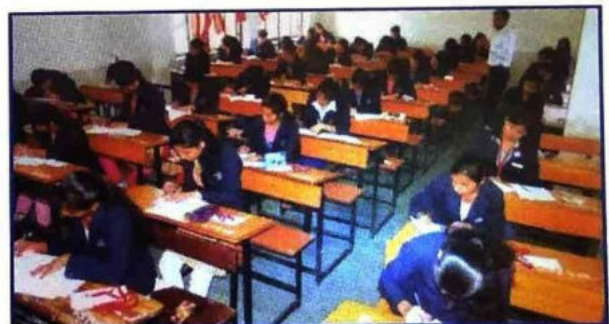
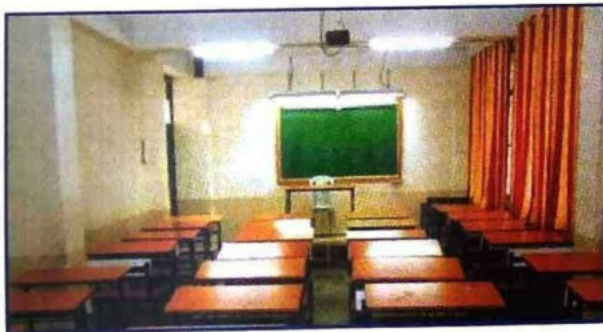
Computer Laboraory



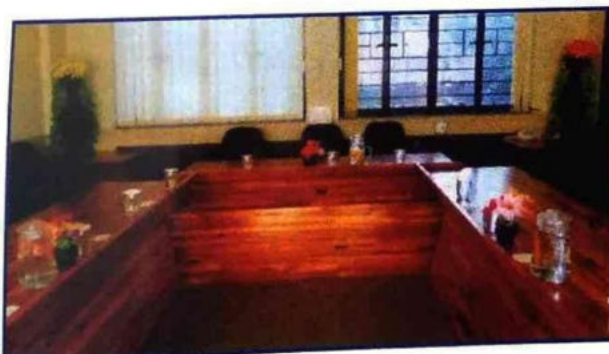

3.0 Admission procedure adopted by the admission committee

- 3.2 The candidate will be required to bring with her the original documents for verification before the admission is confirmed.
- 3.3 In case the candidate is unable to produce original marks certificate and if all other documents tally, she may be given one day's time to produce original certificate, provided that she promises to bring the certificate within the stipulated time limit, her admission will be liable to be cancelled.
- 3.4 In the absence of other original documents or in the event of any discrepancy found in any of her documents her name will be liable to be removed from the merit List.
- 3.5 The candidate selected for admission will be required to remit the fees immediately.

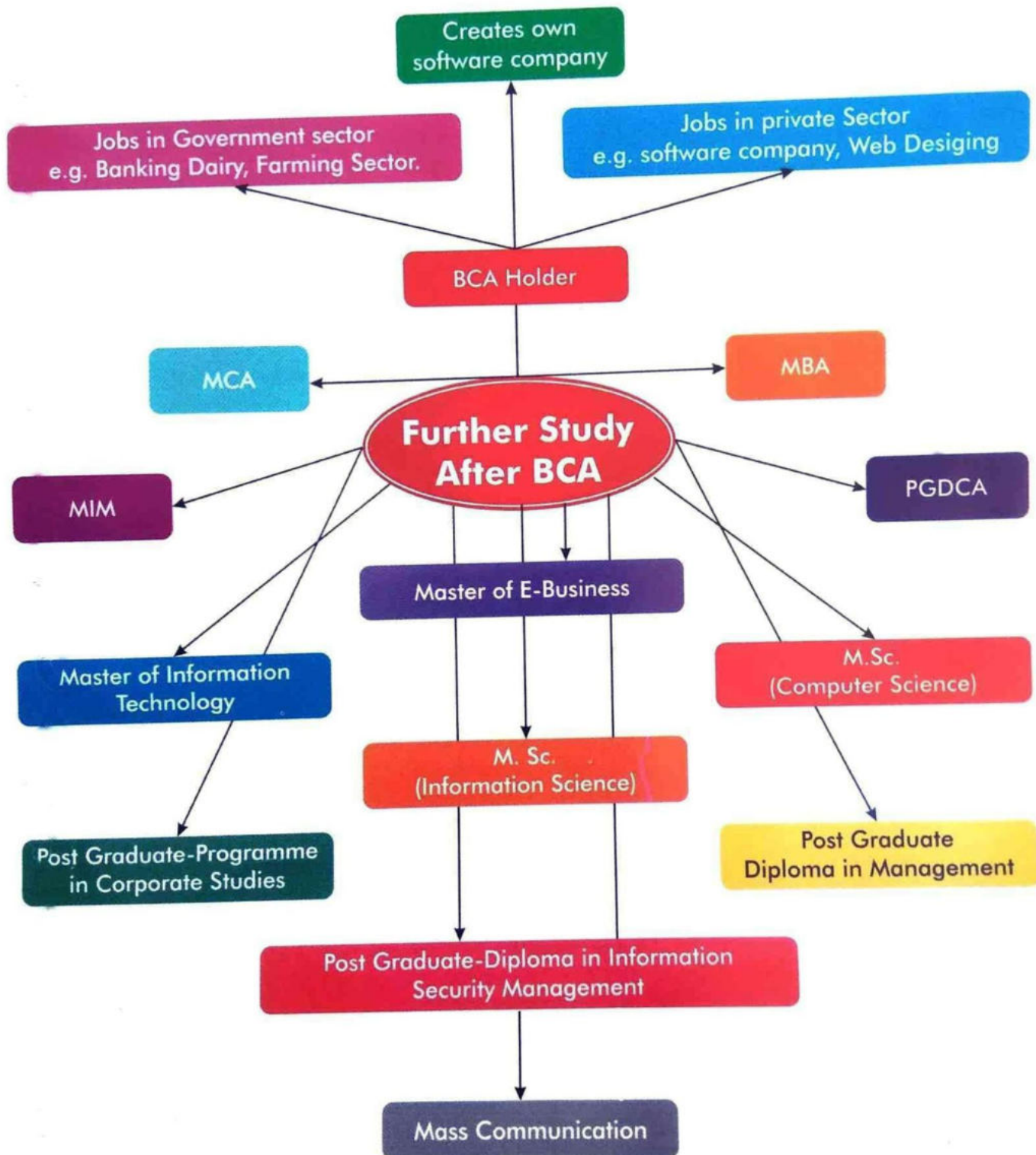

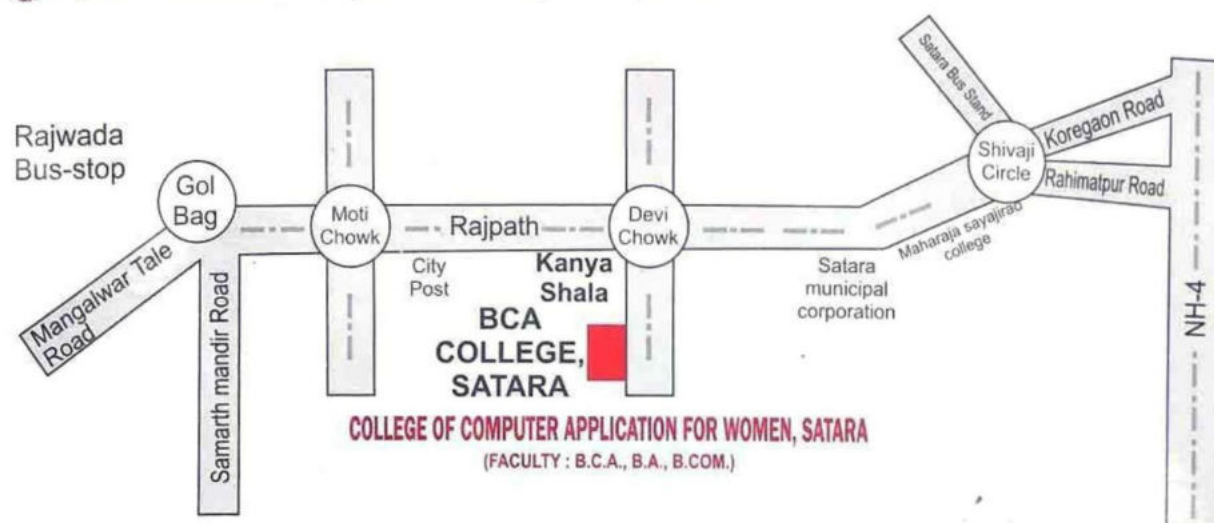
